• * The Police Treatment Centre (PTC) is a registered police charity providing residential treatment, support and recuperation, including intensive, police specific physiotherapy and rehabilitation. They also provide treatment and counselling for psychological issues for injured and ill police officers and retired officers. £7.80 pm

• The PTCs are located at Harrogate, North Yorkshire and Auchterader, Fife



• Gives financial assistanceto dependants of officers who have died or who have been permanently incapcitated as a result of injuries sustained in the course of police duty.£0.25 pm



• ** St George's Police Childrens Trust (SGPCT) is a registered charity. The SGPCT aims to support Police families by helping to ease the financial pressures of bringing up children in the face of life changing circumstances. This could involve the loss of either parent (whether or not they are a serving or retired officer) or the Police Officer parent being unable to earn an income due to illness or injury sustained on or off duty. Please ensure that you inform your family you contribute to the SGPCT so they can access support should they need it. £1.50 pm



• **Durham Constbulary Benevolent Fund** - This is a locally managed Force fund which provides financial assistance to serving and retired officers, their widow(er)s and dependents in time of need. £1.00 pm



• **Durham Constbulary Retirement Fund** - The Retirement Fund pays a lump sum to any member retiring on ill health or injury pension or with more than 25 yrs service. *** Only payable to members of the DRF by members of the DRF. £0.50 when requested

* With effect from **14 Feb 2013** a special relationship is in place whereby the PTC offers new recruits a 12 month donation free period. They **must** sign up to donate to the charity during their **first month** of service.

** The St George's Police Children Trust also offers 12 months free when students sign up in their first month.

*** The DRF will deduct through pay, 50p for any DRF member officer retiring in that month. If 10 officers retire in a month but only 2 are DRF, then the contribution requested will be £1 for that month.
