Additional Wellbeing Support For Retired Officers

From January 2023, we are excited to announce that the PTC will offer a new Wellbeing Programme to our Retired Officer Donors.

The Retired Officers Wellbeing Programme will be a one week structured programme designed specifically for those who have retired from the Police Family and have a formal diagnosis of mild to moderate anxiety and depression.

Please note, this Programme is not intended to address symptoms of PTSD which require a longer input.

The Programme will offer a 7 Day residential stay, Monday to Sunday, culminating in a weekend stay of relaxation and reflection in the safe environment of either Harrogate of Auchterarder.
There will be 5 days of Group Workshops and Classes including:

- Stress Awareness
- Coping Strategies
- Sleep
- Nutrition
- Resilience
- Mindfulness
- Relaxation Techniques
- Thrive App Introduction

There will also be the option to take part in low-level exercise classes including Tai Chi and Yoga, as well as access to our class-leading gym facilities and pools to build a tailor made fitness and health programme with one of the PTC Fitness Instructors.

The relaxing environment, food and facilities, along with the staff from all departments, helps to provide a place where you can be comfortable and concentrate on your recovery.



Although the Programme will not commence until January 2023, we are accepting applications to attend from November this year. Application forms will be available to download from our website.

To support the delivery of this new service, and after much deliberation, The PTC Board of Trustees voted in their meeting of the 5th August 2022, to increase the weekly donation rate for Retired Officers. From January 2023, the new rate to donate to the PTC will be £4.50 per month.



We understand that any increase in the donation rate will not be welcome, but this modest increase will allow the Charity to be financially viable over the next few years, offset the expected reduction in donor numbers, and just as importantly, improve the support and service to both you and your colleagues.

Both of our Centres are continually improving, with the standard and quality of the treatment and facilities being better than ever. The PTC Board of Trustees firmly believe that this new donation rate still represents excellent value for money and that the treatment delivered at the PTC continues to be exceptional.

This increase will help to ensure the long term sustainability and future of the PTC and ensure that we are here to provide treatment and support to this and future generations of Serving and Retired Donors.

2023 Brings Increased Access to Benefits for Retired Officers



From 1st January 2023 Retired Officers who had not previously donated to The Police Children's Charity during their career will become eligible to sign-up and, after an initial 12 month period, will have full access to benefits when needed for any children still within the age range covered by the Charity. This includes access to the two new All Donor Grants looking after the mental wellbeing of any children up to the age of 25yrs. Eligibility still costs just 35p a week! 
Win a Golfing Break for Four People
