



Welfare Funds A & B POLICE OFFICERS ONLY



Welfare Funds A & B are the charitable donations you can elect to make supporting the Police Treatment Centres, The Police Children's Charity, Police Care UK and Durham Constabulary Benevolent Fund. By donating you also become eligible to benefit from these should the need arise. Below is a brief description of each service and cost.



The Police Treatment Centres

The Police Treatment Centre (PTC) is a registered police charity providing residential and out patient treatment, support and recuperation, including intensive, police specific physiotherapy and rehabilitation. They also provide treatment and counselling for psychological issues for injured and ill police officers and retired officers.

Cost is normally £7.80 pcm however since 14 Feb 2013 the PTC offers new recruits a 12 month donation free period. They **must** sign up to donate to the charity during their **first month** of service.



The Police Children's Charity

Formerly known as



St George's Police Children's Trust

"Providing a helping hand if the unimaginable happens"

The Police Children's Charity (formerly known as the St George's Police Children's Trust) is a registered charity. The Charity aims to support Police families by helping to ease the financial pressures of bringing up children in the face of life changing circumstances. This could involve the loss of either parent (whether or not they are a serving or retired officer) or the police Officer parent being unable to earn an income due to illness or injury sustained on or off duty. Please ensure that you inform your family you contribute to the charity so they can access support should they need it.

Normally £1.50 pcm however the Charity offers a 12 month donation free period when students sign up in their first month of service.



Altogether Better Policing



Police Care UK gives financial assistance to dependants of officers who have died or who have been permanently incapacitated as a result of injuries sustained in the course of police duty. £0.25 pcm



Durham Constabulary Benevolent Fund

This is a locally managed Force fund which provides financial assistance to serving and retired officers, their widow(er)s and dependants in time of need. £1.00 pcm



Durham Constabulary Retirement Fund

This is separate to the WELFARE A and B Funds

The Retirement Fund pays a lump sum to any Fund member retiring on ill health or injury pension or with more than 25 yrs service. Only payable to members of the DRF by members of the DRF. £0.50 per eligible retiree

The DCRF will deduct through pay, 50p for any DRF member officer retiring in that month. If 10 officers retire in a month but only 2 are DRF, then the contribution requested will be £1 for that month.
