New Name, Same fantastic Grants

The St George's Police Children Trust has changed its name and has been re-branded as The Police Children's Charity.

The Charity has always evolved to reflect the changing character and nature of modern policing. Over the last few years we have made significant changes to our eligibility and financial benefit package in order to expand the financial support offered by the Trust. However, we found that the name lacked relevance for the new cohorts coming in and has also been said to not be inclusive for the National Forces we represent. The Trustees have therefore decided to rename the Charity to better represent the work that we do. We are now relaunching the Charity as: **'The Police Children's Charity.'**

Although this is a major name change, the grants and services offered by the Charity remain exactly the same. In fact, there are a few new grants now available for Serving Officers, and we have widened the number of Police roles now eligible to sign-up to the Charity (more details below).

We believe the new image and new name of the Charity, along with the new benefits and added eligible roles, will ensure that The Police Children's Charity is best set to continue serving the needs of the Police Family well in to the future.
