Dear Colleague,

The Police Treatment Centres is a registered Charity which provides treatment and support, including intensive, police-specific, physiotherapy and rehabilitation, for injured and ill Police Family members. Whether it is a physical injury or a wellbeing issue, treatment is provided to help them recover and aid their return back to work.

Almost 4000 Serving and Retired Officers attend one of our two Treatment Centres each year, either in Harrogate, North Yorkshire or in Auchterarder, Perthshire.

The Charity receives no statutory funding and is largely financed by the Officers themselves making a regular donation which allows them to receive treatment when needed which is then free of charge.

Our clinical staff assess each Patient's application individually prior to allocating them an admission date for treatment. To try and ensure that applications for treatment are clinically appropriate we ask Patients to have their application forms signed off by a medical professional such as a GP, and this can also provide contact details if we need further information about their condition or to assist with continuing care.

In order to support Police Officers and in acknowledgment of the treatment that the Charity is able to offer your Patient, we would be most grateful if you would consider not charging for completing their form.
